As we look toward better golfing weather, we must also realize that we should have considerable rainfall in the next three months. It will be the goal of our superintendent Tom Arneman to keep our course in excellent condition and you can help!

Every attempt will be made to minimize restrictions to "Cart Path Only" days, but everyone knows we must protect our fairways when conditions are poor.

Your full cooperation for honoring the "90 Degree Rule" can help tremendously during marginal conditions. Please remember that 90 degrees means driving parallel to the area of your shot, turning directly left or right to your ball, then returning directly to the path. If every player would observe this rule, the wear on fairways could be reduced by approximately 25%.
